

**ATP AUDITIONS:** WE LOOK FOR TALENTED INDIVIDUALS WITH COMMITMENT, STAMINA, A PASSION TO PERFORM, AND THE DESIRE AND WILLINGNESS TO LEARN FROM EACH OTHER AS WELL AS FROM US.

**THERE ARE TWO WAYS TO AUDITION FOR US.** YOU CAN COME TO OUR ON-CAMPUS AUDITIONS OR YOU CAN MEET WITH US IN ONE OF THE CITIES WE VISIT AS PART OF THE NATIONAL UNIFIED AUDITION TOUR. THOSE CITIES ARE NEW YORK, CHICAGO, LAS VEGAS, SAN FRANCISCO AND LOS ANGELES.

**If you come to our campus, you will be asked to spend a day with our faculty.** Prospective students will attend mini-classes, present a monologue, sing and informally chat with instructors and current students. Loose, comfortable clothes are recommended for the mini-classes and time will be given to change into appropriate attire for the acting section of the audition.

**For on-campus auditions, you should prepare one piece of approximately 1 and 1/2 minutes in length.** Choose a piece of either serious or comedic nature from the body of contemporary dramatic literature. Please memorize the piece and avoid the use of props. **For off-campus auditions, you should prepare two contrasting monologues of no longer than 1 and 1/2 minutes each.**

**We will require you to sing sixteen bars of a song,** preferably chosen from the musical theatre repertoire. For on-campus auditions, we will provide the accompanist and you will provide the music. Off campus, we require you to sing the sixteen bars unaccompanied.

**You must submit an application to audition for the Actor Training Program.** The application form must be submitted with a **resume, 8X10 head shot, two letters of recommendation with contact information, a 500-word essay describing why you are pursuing a career in theatre, and a \$40 non-refundable application fee.** The application form can be downloaded from our web site ([www.theatre.utah.edu](http://www.theatre.utah.edu)).
